- 5. Show proper respect and care for life forms when using them in research. Do not conduct unnecessary or imperfectly designed experiments, relevant laws and institutional and governmental policies.
- The research should not be in the form of misconduct or FFP i.e. "fabrication, falsification, or plagiarism".
- If any researcher is found to be guilty of plagiarism is liable for severe punishment.
